Bowers. It also continues its foray into the world of table art with a brand-new project designed by Davide Oldani.

During Milan Design Week 2024, the Cassina Store Milan will set the stage for a special poetical installation, where these extraordinary furnishings will become the protagonists of an artistic, theatrical, enigmatic and surprising narrative curated by Philippe Starck for this occasion.

20 years of the Charlotte Perriand Collection

2024 also marks the 20th anniversary of the Charlotte Perriand Collection and Cassina celebrates the work of this versatile designer, indisputable protagonist of design history, with an exclusive selection of never mass-produced models and previously unseen versions of icons already in the catalogue.

An ever-growing lighting catalogue

This year, the Cassina Lighting Collection expands, revealing the Charles & Ray Eames models, produced today for the first time on an industrial scale, and welcoming new designs that bear the signature of Neri&Hu and *maestro* Ico Parisi, along with projects by Linde Freya Tangelder that complete the *Wax, Stone, Light* line.



Cassina Cultural Landscapes: a Mediterranean journey

The Cassina Outdoor 2024 Collection was carefully crafted to furnish living, dining and poolside spaces with eclectic products by acclaimed designers such as Antonio Citterio, Rodolfo Dordoni, Piero Lissoni, Patricia Urquiola, Gerrit T. Rietveld, Le Corbusier, Pierre Jeanneret and Charlotte Perriand. Further to the models already unveiled during Paris Design Week 2024, the *Trampoline Lounge Chair* has been added to expand the *dining* line by Patricia Urquiola.

On the Rocks a tribute to Le Corbusier by Cassina and Bottega Veneta

Cassina and Bottega Veneta, in close collaboration with Fondation Le Corbusier, continue the narrative begun during the *maison's* Winter 24 fashion show by presenting the *On the Rocks* installation at Palazzo San Fedele. In a tribute to the iconic *LC14 Tabouret Cabanon, Roquebrune-Cap-Martin 1952* by Le Corbusier, the installation will feature as protagonists the *tabourets* created for the show (made unique by a wood-burning technique), along with a new limited-edition tribute characterised by the distinctive woven motif hand-crafted by Bottega Veneta artisans.

On the Rocks is located in piazza San Fedele 1/3 and is open to the public from April 16th to 20th.
